National Society of Professional Engineers*
Engineer of the Year Award

1. Purpose. The National Society of Professional Engineers (NSPE) makes this award to provide recognition for the accomplishment of engineers who serve in the Federal Government.
2. The Award. Individual agency award winners (one from the Corps) and the Federal Engineer of the Year Award Winner (to be chosen from the agency winners) will be honored and given a plaque at the National Engineers Week Dinner to be held in Washington, D.C. in February each year.
3. Eligibility. Any professional engineer in the Corps, either military or civilian, who during the last year (from 15 December of the past year to 15 December of the current year) has received one of the following is eligible to be nominated: an outstanding performance award; a highly successful or exceptional rating; or an honorary or monetary award recognizing excellence in engineering.
4. Basis for Selection. Nominees will be considered and selected in accordance with the following criteria:
 - a. Educational and Collegiate Achievements
 - (1) Advanced Degrees
 - (2) Honor Societies, Offices Held
 - b. Professional Society Activities
 - (1) Offices Held
 - (2) Committee Assignments/Responsibilities
 - (3) Awards
 - c. Technical Society Activities
 - (1) Offices Held
 - (2) Committee Assignments/Responsibilities
 - d. Civic and Humanitarian Activities

- e. Continuing Competence During Last Three Years
 - (1) Graduate Studies

5. Nomination of Candidates. Each Division Commander is invited to submit one nominee. The nominee must be submitted to CDR USACE (DAEN-ECE) WASH DC 20314, not later than 15 December each year.

6. Details

a. Nominations will be submitted in the format provided by NSPE including the original and five copies. The nomination will be accompanied by a cover letter from the nominating Division Commander stating which of the required ratings or Awards (see paragraph 3 above) the nominee has received in the last year.

b. The Division Nominees submitted to DAEN-ECE will be sent to a judging panel, appointed by NSPE, who will make the selection of the Corps nominee. The Corps nominee will then compete with the other agency nominees for the "Federal Engineer of the Year Award."
